<u>Seniors – Planning Ahead Program Update</u>

Earlier this year Lakeview received funding from the Federal New Horizons Seniors Grant Program to develop a program called Seniors – Planning Ahead. The purpose of the program was to educate Seniors on topics related to death and dying so that they could confirm what plans they had in place and that they understood the importance of talking about their wishes and plans with their families.

The program was offered twice this year with a total of 64 seniors attending. Topics included wills & estate planning, powers of attorney, advance care planning, options for end of life care, estate taxes, role of the executor, funerals and grief and bereavement.

Many thanks to Carla Blakley who identified the need for this education, Lily Tingley who developed and submitted the New Horizons Grant application and the volunteer team who provided refreshments and wonderful lunches to the participants. Finally, many thanks are extended to our guest presenters who didn't hesitate to volunteer their time, topic expertise and knowledge.

Due to the overwhelming positive response and interest in the Seniors – Planning Ahead program, we have applied for funding to offer the program again in 2025. We will not hear until February, 2025 if our grant application has been approved.
